Have a Great Research Idea? SAMSUNG Is Interested!

The GRO Program is SAMSUNG(Samsung Electronics & affiliated Samsung companies)'s academic research collaboration platform. We annually call for innovative research proposals, open to world-leading universities to foster collaborative research relationships.

Selected proposals will receive financial support for one year ranging from USD \$70,000 to \$100,000 including reasonable overhead. (In some cases, larger awards may be possible for especially outstanding proposals) Awards may be renewed up to three years, based on research outcomes and necessity for further research partnership driven by SAMSUNG.

2014 GRO Application Starts in April

The Call for Proposal (CFP) with this year's special subjects opens in April.

All eligible applicants should submit application forms by June 13 for proposal screening.

Research proposal will be accepted only via the GRO online submission site.
